

Introduction

Scope. This history chronicles the story of the Sheppard family whose lineage can be traced through Wy and Alice Sheppard, lifelong Grand Forks residents.

Organization. The story begins 150 years ago -- in 1871 – when the George W. Aker became the first permanent resident in of Grand Forks and other ancestors among the earliest settlers in eastern North Dakota and western Minnesota. This account is organized in six sections:

First Generation: Wy and Alice's grandparents, who represented the coming together of eight original families.

Second Generation: Wy and Alice's parents – Clarence and Clara Sheppard and Frank and Genevieve Paige -- as well as their brothers and sisters (along with their siblings' descendants).

Third Generation: Wy and Alice, including recollections by family members.

Fourth Generation: Wy and Alice's children, Jean and Bob.

Fifth Generation: Wy and Alice's four grandchildren – Sabin, Nate, Jenna, and Hannah.

Sixth Generation: Wy and Alice's 11 great-grandchildren. (Upon one or more of them will fall the task of updating this history for future generations.)

As a starting point, readers are invited to review the accompanying onepage Sheppard Family Six Generations At-a-Glance chart.

Photographs. The history includes virtually all of the known photographs of Wy and Alice's grandparents and their ancestors and most of the extant images of their parents. The photographs of Wy and Alice and their children were selected from family memorabilia retrieved from Wy and Alice's basement after the 1997 Grand Forks flood. Artifacts included aunt Laura Aker Green's several photo albums of snapshots of her family, her husband's family, and various friends she visited. Photos of the fifth and sixth generations include those collected by Alice Sheppard or were curated or contributed by families.



Registration is required; members must be age 13 or older. The site is free and open to the public as a service of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints and shares records with Ancestry.Com.

Presentation of Information. For consistency, siblings in each section are listed in order of birth. For enhanced readability and for quick reference, full names and dates and places of births, marriages and deaths appear in the left margin. Individuals are buried in the same town as the place of death, except as noted. Cemetery information is provided where known, except for the Sheppard and Aker family members who passed away in Grand Forks (all buried at Memorial Park Cemetery-North) and for Lowe and Woods family members who died in Forest River (all buried at Memorial Park Cemetery in that city). See the adjacent legend of frequently used abbreviations.

Sources. This family history was informed by four streams of genealogy research conducted prior to 2000 by now-deceased extended family members. Researchers included cousin Verna Lowe Asmussen (the Lowes and Woods), aunt Nell Richardson (the Paiges), and cousin Harold Noble (the Akers). Additional family members were identified and details regarding dates and places of births, marriages and deaths were collected and/or verified using online genealogical websites such as Family Search.com. Ancestry.com. Genealogy Bank.com and Find A Grave.com. Special thanks go to Lisa Monson Sheppard, Deborah Murphy and Beckie Lowe for sharing their earlier online research.

Online Family Tree. An interactive, updatable Family Tree that includes deceased individuals can be found on Family Search.com. Begin by searching for Kenneth Wyman Sheppard (ID No. GHSQ-WQM) to access information about the Sheppard, Aker, Paige and Lowe Families. Follow the right-pointing arrows and pull-down menus for Children to track the lineages of various branches of the family. Grandchildren of Susan Sheppard also can explore their Fleck family ancestry beginning with the records of Sue's parents, John Fleck, ID No. G36C-KY4, or Audrey Crevier, ID No. LYRJ-QRP). Note: Living Persons (versus Deceased Persons) can be added on the site, but can be viewed only by the contributor in order to protect personal privacy.

Archival Preservation. All original and reproduced materials pertaining to the Sheppard, Paige, Lowe and Woods families have been donated to the newly established Wy and Alice Sheppard Collection (#**0000**) in the Elwyn B. Robinson Department of Special Collections at the UND Chester Fritz Library. At the same time, materials related to Laura Aker Green and her father, sisters and husband were added to the Laura Green Papers established in 1991 (Collection #1234).
